The Leavers Department provides a dynamic approach to Post 16 education. We provide different vocational skills including Salon skills, Horticulture and Hospitality.

# Leavers

On a weekly basis your child will need to bring in £2.00 pocket money per week. This money is used for students to purchase items such as Tea, Coffee, Squash , Fruit and healthy snacks.

Students who access Garth Olwg ICT facilities and Garth Olwg OCN / Agored Cymru courses are also advised to bring in money to purchase items for their breaks and pay for public transport (if required). Please ensure that you provide a purse / wallet to keep the money in. Students will be responsible for their own money.

Every term your child will need to bring £6 for Food Skills. This money will be used to purchase any items for food Skills lessons.

As you might know the Leavers had a very successful prom at The Vale of Glamorgan Golf Club on June 25th 2010. We will not be responsible this year for organising the prom in 2011 as in previous years, Parc Lane Special School is going to organise it and they will let us know as soon as possible where it is going to be. ## **A Valid Bus Pass**
