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

Who are we?

The CLA Education Team are made up of a CLA Advisory Teacher, CLA Education Coordinator, 2 Specialist Educational Psychologists for CLA, CLA Education Officer and Administrative Assistant. The team is managed by the Head of Educational Psychology with the Deputy Educational Psychologist line managing the team.



We support CLA in a range of ways, including:

- Providing consultation, advice and guidance to school staff, social care professionals and parents/carers;
- Deliver direct and indirect interventions and programmes;
- Provide training to school staff;
- Support schools working towards becoming 'CLA Friendly Schools';
- Provide support and guidance to Foster Carers;
- Carry out assessments of needs;
- Support the transition of CLA from school to school/college;
- Liaise with other professionals and Local Authorities.
